1. Pharisees' disciples and Herodians' truth:

1.1 They want to get rid of Jesus, they are united in a wicked way.

1.2 They were used but allowed by God in the plan of salvation.

1.3 They told the truth but only Jesus is the Truth who frees us.

2. Power and authority of the governor's trick:

2.1 Governor keeps people safe & order in the society

2.2 Their authority comes from God not from Caesar/priest

2.3 All authorities could be a trick in the wrong hands

3. Patient Jesus' response to tricks:

3.1 Jesus has the real power and authority to refuse and rebuke the trick

3.2 Jesus allowed this to happen upon Himself by listening patiently with people

3.3 Jesus learned all these tricks for 33 years and no surprise to Him

4. Passionate Jesus' treat:

4.1 People need the Lord, both the unsaved and the saved

4.2 Jesus reminds us that we have to return things to its original owner
